Masters Swimming Australia (MSA), Masters Swimming SA (MSSA) and Atlantis Masters Swimming Club ("Atlantis") are committed to providing a safe, fair and inclusive environment within which we can enjoy swimming.

The Member Protection Policy sets out codes of behaviour for coaches, swimmers and administrators. The swimmers' code requires that swimmers give their best at all times; participate for their own enjoyment and benefit; and play by the rules and show respect for other swimmers, coaches, officials and spectators. Atlantis Masters Swimming Policy

A breach of the Member Protection Policy includes (among other things):

• breaching the code of behaviour, for example intentionally breaking rules and being disrespectful of other swimmers or officials at a swim meet;

- bringing the Masters' swimming into disrepute;
- discriminating against, for example behaving in such a way at a Masters' Swimming activity that results in police being called or resulting in negative media attention;
- harassing or bullying (including cyber bullying) any person;
- verbally or physically assaulting another person,
- intimidating another person or creating a hostile environment within the sport.

Atlantis has developed this policy to sit alongside the national policy and has procedures in place to respond to any complaints or grievances.
